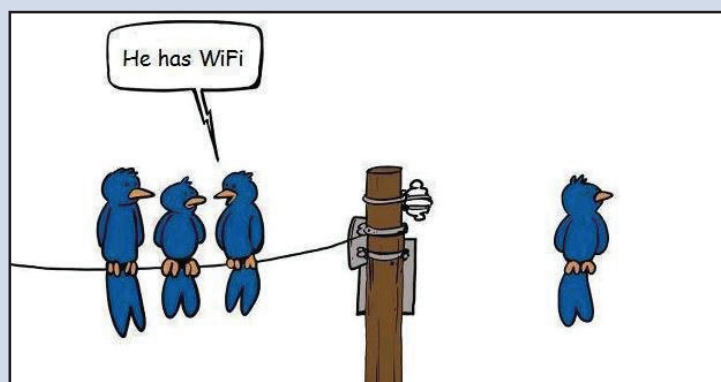
On-Site RV Rentals
