Membership Updates and Reminders

Throughout the past few camping seasons, we have seen an increase of short notice member cancellations and no shows. This creates unused/empty sites throughout the parks which could otherwise be reserved for other RV'ers if the cancellations were made with longer notice. With this in mind, we have implemented a cancellation policy for the HTR members as follows:

- Reservation cancellations made outside 72 hours of arrival date will not be charged cancellation fee.
- Cancellations made within 72 hrs. will be charged one night's fee.
- Failure to show up on reservation day (no-show) will result in forfeiture of the whole reservation and the member will be billed for up to three nights.
- Please call the registration office if you are not arriving on your reservation date so we may free up your site for someone else.

This policy is noted on the Business Terms & Conditions page on our online reservation system and on our website under the Member Usage information tab. We encourage you to review these policies on our website periodically as they are updated frequently.

Some of the other membership policies to take note of are as follows:

Booking an extra day to get a "late check out" time or leaving before scheduled checkout day without advising Registration office. Doing this usually prevents the site from being booked for another RV'ers' requested stay and leaves the site unused for the night(s).

Members are not permitted to leave their unit unoccupied overnight on a site without permission from the Park Manager. Such permission is restricted to cases of emergency and is at the sole discretion of the Park Manager. The membership was not designed for reserving and dropping off the camping unit for your allowed days and stopping in for short term visits when time permits. For the short term Rv'ers, we have a separate "out time" of 2 nights rather than 14 nights. This allows the flexibility of using your membership for two or three nights at a time and not having to wait for 14 nights to return to the park. This will also free up the site so other RV'ers may enjoy the resort.

Member reservations are open for 2024 so Book Now!! HTR members may start making their reservations on September 1st for the following year. Please visit our individual park listings on our website, www.htr.ca, to make online reservations or call the park directly.

Manning Park Resort


Winter Member Bookings
